## ELECTORAL ACT 1965-1970

### BY-ELECTION FOR THE CONSTITUENCY OF UBENIDE

Pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution and of the Electoral Act 1965-1970 I KENAS, Speaker do hereby advise that a Writ has been issued for the election of one member of the Parliament of Nauru to fill the vacant office of a member for the Constituency of Ubenide.

### BY-ELECTION - CONSTITUENCY OF UBENIDE

ATTENTION of all persons in the districts of Denigomodu, Baiti, Nibok and Uaboe is drawn to the by-election to be held on Saturday the 14th of August to fill one vacant seat in the Parliament of Nauru for the Constituency of Ubenide.

#### NOTE

1. Voting is compulsory.
2. All Nauruans over 20 years living in the above Districts must be enrolled

as electors before Saturday the 24th of July.

3. All Nauruans who are on the rolls for any of the above Districts and who have moved to another District must apply to have their names transferred to the roll of their new District.
4. All persons wishing to nominate candidates may collect nomination forms from the Deputy Electoral Registrar, Secretary for Justice's Office and lodge the same before noon on the 31st of July with the Returning Officer, the Acting Chief Secretary.
5. Candidates need only be nominated by two electors and it is requested that no more than one nomination paper for each candidate be lodged with the Returning Officer. Only the first valid nomination paper for each candidate will be accepted.
