CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

APPOINTMENT BY CABINET UNDER ARTICLE 21

CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER ARTICLE 23

The portfolio of Island Development and Industry.

Minister for Finance

The portfolio of Works and Community Services.

The above assignments of responsibility for the business of the Government of Nauru shall be effective during the absence from the Republic of His Excellency President Hammer DeRoburt, O.B.E., and the Honourable Buraro Detudamo, M.P.
