SHORT TERM TEACHING VACANCIES

From time to time, due mainly to the temporary absence of regular teachers, short term vacancies occur in infant schools. It is known that there will be several such vacancies during the remainder of 1975.

It is desired to maintain a list of persons who may be called upon at short notice. The duties will be to assist with classes under the immediate supervision of qualified teachers and following prepared courses. In some cases appointments could be for several months, in other cases for a week or two only.

Women who are willing to assist in the way indicated are invited to submit their names to the Chief Secretary, stating educational background and providing information about any previous teaching experience. Formal training and previous experience are desirable but not essential. Salaries paid will have regard to experience and will be related to salaries payable to Nauruan teachers.
