## COURTS ACT 1972

### COUNSEL'S DRESS ORDER 1975

IN EXERCISE of the power conferred on me by Section 71 of the Courts Act 1972, I hereby order that, with effect from 10th December, 1975 the dress to be worn -

(a) in the District Court by barristers and solicitors and by pleaders shall be -

(i) in the case of male persons, a lounge suit of plain sober colour, white shirt, collar and tie, and

- (ii) in the case of female persons, a dress, or a blouse and skirt, of plain sober colour:
- (b) in the Supreme Court by barristers and solicitors shall be -

  - (ii) in the case of female persons, a dress of plain sober colour or a skirt of plain sober colour and a white blouse, wing collar, barrister's bands, barrister's gown and barrister's wig, and
- (c) in the Supreme Court by pleaders shall be -
  - (i) in the case of male persons, a lounge suit of plain sober colour, white shirt, collar, tie and pleader's gown, and
  - (ii) in the case of female persons, a dress or a blouse and skirt of plain sober colour and a pleader's gown.

The Counsel's Dress Order 1973 made by me on 3rd May, 1973, is hereby revoked.
