DECLARATION OF ELECTED COUNCILLOR

Section 12 of the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951-1967 provides inter alia, that there shall be one Councillor elected for the Districts of Boe and Buada, one Councillor for the group of Districts of Anibare, Ijuw and Anabar and two Councillors for the group of Districts of Baiti, Uaboe, Nibok and Denigomodu.

There being only one candidate nominated for the Districts of Boe, Yaren, Buada and Anibare, Ijuw and Anabar, I, SIMON GILLETT, Returning Officer acting in pursuance of Section 22(3) of the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951-1967 do hereby declare:

- (1) That Hammer DeRoburt is duly elected as Councillor representing the District of Boe;
- (2) That Joseph Detsimea Audoa is duly elected as Councillor representing the District of Yaren;
- (3) That Austin Bernicke is duly elected as Councillor representing the District of Buada;
- (4) That James Agoko Doguape is duly elected as Councillor representing the Districts of Anibare, Ijuw and Anabar.

POLLS TO BE TAKEN

There being a greater number of candidates than the number of Councillors to be elected for the Electoral Districts set out below, a poll is to be taken in each of those Districts on the seventeenth day of January, 1976 commencing at one o'clock in the afternoon and closing at six o'clock in the afternoon at the places to be determined by the Council as the places at which the poll is to be taken.
