CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

APPOINTMENT BY CABINET UNDER ARTICLE 21

A. Position: Deputy Headmaster, Aiwo Primary School

 4. To advise teachers and students on the use of library materials;
 5. To take charge of classes as required;
 6. Other duties as assigned by the Head-master to ensure the efficient running of the school.
