CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

PUBLIC SERVICE ACT 1961-1975HOURS OF ATTENDANCESECTION 39(2)

DETERMINATION OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSIONER WITH RESPECT TO LAUNDRESSES, SEAMSTRESSES AND CARETAKER/CLEANERS OF THE NAURU GENERAL HOSPITAL.

In accordance with the powers conferred upon me and by virtue of Section 39 Sub-section (2) of the Public Service Act 1961-1975, I determine:-

- (i) that the hours of duty for Laundresses, Seamstresses and Caretaker/Cleaners at the Nauru General Hospital shift worked between 7.00 a.m. - 11.30 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. - 4.30 p.m. on each day of the week Monday to Sunday inclusive.
- (ii) that no officer or employee engaged in this capacity shall exceed a total of forty hours in any one week without the payment of overtime.
- (iii) that no shift worked shall exceed eight hours continuously.
- (iv) that a shift may be split into not more than two sub-shifts.
- (v) the effective date for the introduction of these hours of duty will be Monday 4th October, 1976.
