POSITION: Draftsman (Male or Female)
SALARY: \$3900-\$4776 (T3/5)
DUTIES: Under the direction of the Chief Draftsman to draft plans, carry out survey computations and in particular to maintain the Land Record and other office records and to assist generally as required.
QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must possess an aptitude for drafting work including reasonable mathematical ability at Form 4 Secondary level.
