# NAURUAN SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATIONS 1978

- 1. The Minister for Health & Education has announced that the Government has decided to award up to 20 Scholarships to Nauruan students to undertaken secondary education overseas commencing in 1979.
- 2. Selection will be based on written tests and examinations. Scholarships will be awarded only to candidates assessed as having the capacity to take full advantage of the additional opportunities afforded by schools overseas compared with secondary schools in the Republic.
- 3. Selection will be at two levels :
  - (i) Lower Age secondary school students under the age of 13 years 6 months as at 31 December 1978 (i.e. those born after 30 June 1965).
  - (ii) Upper Age secondary students at Form 3 and above and under the age of 17 years as at 31 December 1978, (i.e. those born after 31 December 1961).
- 4. Examinations for both Lower Age and Upper Age candidates will be conducted on Tuesday, 15 August 1978. All candidates will be required to sit for papers in the following:

Mathematics Reading Comprehension Word Meaning Written Expression

In addition, a Learning Ability Test will be administered on the same day to indicate candidates' potential.

- 5. Through the courtesy of the Nauru Local Government Council the examinations will be held at the Civic Centre.
- 6. Students to whom Scholarships are awarded will be enrolled overseas in schools approved by the Minister, who will be guided by parents' wishes.
- 7. The Scholarships will cover the cost of tuition, board and lodging, prescribed textbooks, school stationery, other compulsory school fees and travel to and from Nauru once per

year and provide a generous clothing allowance. Parents will be required to pay for additional clothing requirements and meet out-of-pocket expenses. Pocket money provided by parents should not exceed limits set by schools.

- 8. Scholarship students will be expected to apply themselves diligently to their studies at all times. Scholarships are reviewed annually by the Minister or at more frequent intervals if progress is unsatisfactory. A Scholarship may be cancelled or discontinued for unsatisfactory results or serious misbehaviour.
- 9. At senior secondary level the subjects to be studied will be decided in consultation with the Nauruan Welfare Officer and/or the Department of Education.
- 10. On completion of their secondary course students may apply for cadetships to undertake tertiary studies or for apprenticeships overseas depending upon the results obtained in their final examinations, their aptitudes and the needs of the Republic.
- 11. Any students wishing to be considered for a Scholarship should submit his or her name to the Principal of one of the Republic's two secondary schools. Details of the examination arrangements will be notified to the Principals and all candidates by the Acting Director of Education.
