DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & EDUCATION

Applications are invited for a vacant position in the Dispensary at the Nauru General Hospital.

Preference will be given to applicants with training as a Pharmacist or Dispenser but applications will be considered from persons with experience in a pharmacy or a dispensary: persons without experience need not apply.

The appointee will be responsible to the Hospital's Executive Officer for the operation of the Dispensary. The appointee will be assisted by a local officer who has been working in the Dispensary for two years.

Salary will be in the range \$4243 - 5263 (T2-T4) depending upon qualifications and experience, although a higher salary may be available to a person with full pharmaceutical qualifications.
