**POSITION:** Headmaster, Aiwo Primary School

**SALARY:** A\$8299 - 8875 per annum.

**DUTIES:** To be responsible to the Director of Education for the successful operation of Aiwo Primary School, including the direction of staff and curriculum development. Some teaching will be necessary.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Teaching experience at mid-primary level preferably experienced in teaching English to children for whom it is a second language. Direct involvement in curriculum development for similar age group, proven ability to administer a school of the type either at Headmaster or Deputy Headmaster level.
