PUBLIC SERVICE APPEALS BOARD

ELECTION OF MEMBER

WHEREAS Article 70 of the Constitution provides for a Public Service Appeals Board consisting of the Chief Justice, one member appointed by Cabinet and one member elected by public officers

AND WHEREAS Section 81(1) of the Public Service Act 1961-1975 provides that the election of the member to be elected by contributors shall be conducted in such manner as the Cabinet, by notice in the Gazette, determines :

NOW the Cabinet hereby determines as follows :

1. John Shuttleworth shall be the Returning Officer and shall, subject to the directions of the Chief Secretary, make all necessary arrangements for the conduct of the election.
2. The Returning Officer shall prepare a list, Department by Department, of all persons who are or will be permanent officers of the Public Service on the date appointed for the election.
3. Nominations shall be in writing and in accordance with the following form :

These forms will be available in all Government offices.

- 4. Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer before 12.00 noon on 19 February 1979.
- 5. The nomination form shall be signed by the candidate and by five other contributors.
- 6. A candidate may withdraw his nomination at any time before nominations close by giving written notice of his withdrawal to the Returning Officer.
- 7. The Returning Officer shall publicise the names of the candidates as soon as practicable after the closing of nominations.
- 8. The election shall be held on 5 March 1979 during normal office hours and contributors shall cast their vote at the following places :

<u>Polling Place</u>	<u>Contributors on staff of :</u>
(a) Nauruan Affairs Office	All offices not covered under (b) to (d) below.
(b) Works	Works and Nauruan Housing
(c) Post Office	Department of Finance (including Treasury and Post Office) and audit staff
(d) Nauru General Hospital	Health

- 9. The Returning Officer shall appoint a person to preside at each Polling Place.
- 10. Each Ballot Paper for the election shall be similar to that used for elections under the provisions of the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951-1967 and a Ballot Paper shall be invalid if it does not comply with the provisions of Section 28 of that Ordinance.
- 11. The results of the election shall be determined as if the provisions of Section 32(1) of the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance apply.

12. The District Court shall be the Court of disputed elections and any dispute concerning the election shall be determined as if the provisions of Division 2A or Part II of the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance apply.
