Nursing

Applications are invited from young people interested in Nursing as a career.

There is a number of immediate vacancies for nursing orderlies. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age. Education to at least Form 4 level is desirable.

The health Department conducts 3 year full time courses of training for certificated nurses which opens the way for promotion to higher positions. Students for these courses are normally selected from Nursing Orderlies. It is anticipated that such a course will begin later this year.

Nursing is not just a job but it is very satisfying work for those who are really interested. It is also demanding work. Nurses must be on duty in the hospital continuously and those who take up nursing may be rostered at nights and weekends and on public holidays.
