NOMINATIONS

GENERAL ELECTIONS 1980

Intending Candidates for Election to membership of the Parliament of Nauru are advised-

(a) That Nominations can only validly be made after the Rolls have been closed for each District (i.e. after Saturday 15th November 1980) and on or before Nomination Day (i.e. on or before Saturday 22nd November 1980).

(b) Nomination Papers may be handed to me at Chief Secretary's Office during Public Service Office Hours, Monday to Friday 17th November to 21st November 1980 inclusive. To assist intending candidates I will also be available in the Chief Secretary's Office between 8.00 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturday 22nd November. Nominations will close at 12 noon on 22nd November.

(c) Nominations must be in Form 6 of the Schedule to the Electoral Act 1965-1973 and signed by at least two Electors who are on the Roll for the Electoral District concerned (i.e. that in which the candidate intends to stand for election). The intending candidate must also be an Elector who is on the Roll for the Electoral District concerned.

(d) Nomination Forms are available from me.

(e) Candidates who have been duly nominated, and wish to withdraw their candidature may do so by notice in writing signed by them given to me not later than Saturday 29th November,
