VACANCIES: SECTION 20

Applications are invited from persons both inside and outside the Public Service for appointment, promotion or transfer to the following positions.

DEPARTMENT OF ISLAND DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRY

(Directorate of Telecommunications)

1. POSITION: DIRECTOR OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS
- SALARY: \$11,040-\$12,120 S1 (Nauruan)
- DUTIES: Directly responsible to the Secretary for Island Development and Industry for the operation and maintenance of all public telecommunications services, and the technical operation and maintenance of Civil Aviation navigational aids and Flight Information Centre equipment. The scope of responsibility embraces:
- a) international services operating through a Standard B Satellite Earth Station with two immediate distant end destinations;
 - b) the national telephone system consisting of 1,200 subscribers connected via two crossbar type telephone exchanges;
 - c) an HF station to provide back-up for the Earth Station and a direct link to Kiribati;
 - d) a restricted MF/HF/VHF shipping watch in the maritime mobile service;
 - e) Civil Aviation equipment including NDB, DME, VOR, HF/VHF and other associated equipment;
 - f) VHF land mobile system and paging system;
 - g) accounting with distant end Telecommunication Administrations and all negotiations relating thereto and national/international billing. Recommending changes in tariffs when necessary; and

h) licensing of stations in the maritime mobile and amateur radio services etc.

NOTE:

The national/international telephone switching equipment is to be replaced with a digital system using stored programme control techniques in the near future.

The Director is responsible for the control of revenue and expenditure within the Telecommunication sphere of operations, and is expected to advise the Secretary on all matters affecting general policy including annual estimates of financial revenue and expenditure.

QUALIFICATIONS:

First Class Certificate of Proficiency in radio telephony and radiotelegraphy and several years experience in a Telecommunications Senior Administrative position.

2. POSITION:

CROSSEBAR TECHNICIAN

SALARY:

\$6,756-\$7,464 T7/8 (Nauruan)

DUTIES:

Responsible to the Director of Telecommunications through the Telephone Engineer for the operation and maintenance of Two NC100 telephone exchanges, L.M. Ericsson PABX's and key telephone systems etc, and to liaise with the Cable/Lines Technician on telephone faults.

NOTE:

The national/international telephone switching equipment is to be replaced with a digital system using stored programme control techniques in the near future.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must be in possession of a recognised technical certificate issued by a Government, Military or Technical Institute, and should have had several years practical experience on the installation and maintenance of telephone exchange systems and associated equipment.

Applications should be lodged in writing, stating name, age, qualifications and previous experience with the Chief Secretary (through the Senior Administrative Officer) on or before Friday 8th January, 1982.
