NOTIFICATION UNDER NLGC ORDINANCE 1951-1967

1. The Nauru Local Government Council having decided to hold a by-election to fill the vacancy of the councillor of Yaren District caused by the death of Councillor J.D. Audoa, hereby notifies under Section 34(2) of Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951-1967 that the said by-election shall be held on 30th day of June, 1984, at Yaren Primary School between 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. and that the Nomination Day shall be the day fourteen days preceding the date of election i.e. 16th June, 1984, not later than 12 noon.
2. By virtue of the power vested in it under Section 3 of the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951-1967, the Council hereby appoints Mr. J.K. Rai to be the Returning Officer for the purpose of holding by-election for the Yaren District to be held on 30th day of June, 1984.
3. By virtue of the power vested in it under Section 14(1) of the Nauru Local Government Council 1951-1967 the Council having appointed Mr. H.R. TEMAKI, Registrar hereby directs that the Electoral Roll for the District of Yaren shall be kept open until 16th June, 1984, for purpose of exercising power under Section 14 A and 17 of the Nauru Local Government Council Ordinance 1951-1967.

I, S.K.RAI, duly appointed Returning Officer, hereby notify for general information the following schedule in connection with the by-election to be held on the 30th day of June, 1984 to elect a Councillor for the District of Yaren.

NOMINATION DAY - 16th June, 1984 (Saturday - not later than 12 noon)

NOTE : As required by Section 21 of the NLGC Ordinance nomination can only be made by effecting delivery to the Returning Officer on nomination day (not later than 12 noon), a paper in accordance with form C in the schedule giving Christian names and surnames of the candidate, his place of residence and occupation, etc. To facilitate checking of the nomination paper, nominators to write in block letters their name also below their signatures.

CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE BUSINESS
OF GOVERNMENT

IN EXERCISE of the powers in that behalf vested in His Excellency the President, under Article 23 of the Constitution of Nauru, I, HAMMER DEROBURT, President of the Republic of Nauru, hereby assign to the Ministers of the Cabinet of Nauru, set out below, the responsibilities for the business of the Government of Nauru as set out opposite their names:

Minister for Finance

BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT

The Portfolio of the President, External and internal affairs, the Public Service in relation to the business of Government to be undertaken in Nauru by the said Minister.

The Portfolio of the Minister for Island Development and Industry in relation to the business of Government to be undertaken in Nauru by the said Minister.

The assignment of business of government of Nauru as set out above is in addition to and not in substitution for the business of government of Nauru already assigned to the said Ministers. The above assignments of responsibility for the business of government shall be effective during the absence from the Republic of His Excellency President Hammer DeRoburt, G.C.M.G., O.B.E., M.P.
