CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT

In Exercise of the powers in that behalf vested in His Excellency the President, under Article 23 of the Constitution of Nauru, I, BURARO DETUDAMO, being the Minister exercising the functions of His Excellency the President in Nauru under and by virtue of appointment as such by Cabinet under Article 21 of the Constitution of Nauru, hereby assign to the Ministers of the Cabinet of Nauru, as set out below the responsibilities of the business of the Government of Nauru as set out opposite their names:

Minister for Finance

BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT

The Portfolio of the Minister for Justice in relation to the business of Government to be undertaken in Nauru by the said Minister.

The Portfolio of the Minister for Island Development and Industry in relation to the business of Government to be undertaken in Nauru by the said Minister.

The assignments of business of Government of Nauru as set out above is in addition to and not in substitution for the business of the Government of Nauru already assigned to the said Ministers. The above assignments of responsibility for the business of Government shall be effective during the absence from the Republic of His Excellency President Hammer Deroburt, G.C.M.G., O.B.E., M.P. and the Honourable Bernard Dowiyogo, M.P. Minister for Justice.
