THE CONSTITUTION OF NAURU  
ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY  
FOR THE BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT  
(Article 23)

BY VIRTUE of the powers in that behalf vested in me under Article 23 of the Constitution of Nauru and of all other powers enabling me, I. HAMMER DEROBURT, President of the Republic of Nauru, HEREBY ASSIGN to myself and the Ministers of the Cabinet named below the responsibility for the business of the Government of Nauru as set out hereunder opposite my name and the respective names of such Ministers:
