COMMISSION OF INQUIRY TO REVIEW THE NAURUAN BASIC WAGE REGIMEN

PUBLIC NOTICE

It is notified for general information that the Commission of Inquiry to Review the Nauruan Basic Wage Regimen (Sole Commissioner, Mr. Ken Walker) will conduct public hearings to review the regimen of Nauruan basic wage with a view of establishing and recommending a new basic wage regimen with reference to which the Nauruan basic wage may be determined from time to time under Section 27(2) of the Public Service Act 1961-1979. A preliminary public hearing of the Commission will be held at the Court House, Government Offices, Yaren, Republic of Nauru, between 9.30 AM and 12.00 Noon on 23rd April 1987. The date, time and place of subsequent hearings will be announced later on from time to time.

Members of the public, institutions and Government are invited to make brief submissions of their views on the Nauruan Basic Wage Regimen to the Commission. Such submissions may be oral or in writing. Full submissions should be received by the Secretary to the Commission no later than 15th May, 1987.

Anyone wishing to make a submission at this preliminary hearing, should notify Mr. T.R. Ananthakrishnan, Secretary to the Commission of Inquiry to Review the Nauruan Basic Wage Regimen, Department of Finance, Civic Centre, Republic of Nauru, before 4.00 PM on 22nd April 1987. The Department of Civil Aviation has vacancies for Air Hostesses and invites applications from young Nauruan women who are willing to undergo training as Air Hostesses with a view to employment by Air Nauru.

POSITION : Air Hostesses

ELIGIBILITY : Applicants must :

- (a) be at least eighteen (18) years of age and
- (b) supply particulars of their educational standard and present and/or previous employment.

Members of the Public Service are eligible to supply.

Requirement of Training:

Acceptance for training as an Air Hostess does not in itself mean that applicants will be appointed to the Public Service. Those who complete the course successfully will however be eligible for employment in Air Nauru, whether on a permanent or temporary basis.

Training will be undertaken in Nauru, with the exception of some particular procedures, which will be undertaken in Australia or New Zealand. While undergoing training overseas, successful applicants will be provided with accommodation and a subsistence allowance.

SALARY : On appointment as Air Hostesses after completion of training they will be paid commencing salaries as follows:

18 years of age	:	\$4,029 per annum
19 years of age	:	\$4,701 per annum
20 years of age	:	\$6,044 per annum
21 years of age	:	\$6,715 per annum
