PURSUANT to Section 22 read with Schedule 2, Clause 23 of the Nauru Island Council Act. 1992, I, NIKHIL CHANDRA, Returning Officer, for the 1st General Election of the Councillors of the Nauru Island Council held today, the 2nd May, 1992, do hereby determined and declare the results of the elections of the Councillors with votes cast:-

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF AIWO

Mr. ALLAN RIRIAINANG THOMA being the sole candidate, was declared elected Councillor for the seat in 'AIWO' District.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF BOE

Ms. AGNES ENOKOERAK HARRIS being the sole candidate, was declared elected Councillor for the seat in 'BOE' District.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF 'BUADA'

Mr. JOHN PALIK AGIR being the sole candidate, was declared elected Councillor for the seat in 'BUADA' District.

ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF ANABAR, IJUW, ANIBARE

Mr. JAMES DEIRERAGEA being the sole candidate, was declared elected Councillor for the seats in 'ANABAR, IJUW & ANIBARE' Districts.
