NAURUAN COMMUNITY (MISCELLANEOUS) REGULATIONS 1997

In exercise of the powers under Section 5, 7 and 11 of the Nauruan Community Act and all other enabling powers in that behalf, the Cabinet hereby makes the following Regulations:

SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

1. *These Regulations*
 - (a) *may be cited as Nauruan Community (Miscellaneous) Regulations 1997; and*
 - (b) *shall come into force on 25th July 1997*

INTERPRETATION

2. *In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:-*
 - (a) *"Act" means the Nauruan Community Act 1956-1997*
 - (b) *"Board" means the Nauru Citizen Investment Board established under Section 5 (7) of the Act;*

FORM FOR ADMISSION BY A WOMAN TO BECOME A NAURUAN CITIZEN

3. *A woman, not being a Nauruan citizen who is married to a Nauruan citizen or has been married to a man who was throughout the subsistence of the marriage and who wishes to become a Nauruan citizen may apply to Cabinet in accordance with Form 1.*

CABINET MAY CALL FOR INFORMATION ECT,

4. *Cabinet may, on receipt of an application by a woman for admission as a Nauruan Citizen, require such additional information or make such further inquiry, as it may consider necessary to be satisfied that the applicant satisfies the requirements of the Act.*

NAURU CITIZEN INVESTMENT BOARD - ALLOWANCES AND EXPENSES

5. *The Chairman and Members of the Board shall be paid such allowances for attendance at the meetings of the Board and the reimbursement of reasonable expenses properly incurred in connection with its business and deliberations, as the Cabinet may, from time to time, determine.*

MEETING OF THE BOARD

6. *The Board shall meet as often as necessary in order to deal with its business but shall meet at least once each month. Unless otherwise approved by the Minister meetings of the Board shall take place in Nauru.*

PROCEDURE

7. *Subject to any directions by the Cabinet or the Minister the Board shall regulate its own procedure.*
