**NAURU SUPERANNUATION BOARD**  
**ELECTION OF MEMBER**

WHEREAS Section 7 (1) of the Superannuation Board consisting of Three members appointed by Cabinet, one of whom shall be a person who is contributor within the meaning of the Act elected by contributors.

AND WHEREAS Section 7 (2) of that Act provides that the election of the member to be elected by contributors shall be conducted in such manner as the Cabinet, by notice in the Gazette, determines;

NOW the Cabinet hereby determines the following: -

1. Mrs. Doreen Temaki, the Returning Officer, shall, Subject to the directions of the Chief Secretary, make all necessary arrangements for the conduct of the election;
2. The Returning Officer shall prepare a list, Department by Department, of all persons who were, or who became contributors to the Superannuation Fund on the payday immediately preceding the closing of nominations for the election;
3. Nominations shall be in writing and in accordance with the following form;

4. Nomination must be lodged with the Returning Officer before 5:00 p.m. on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2003
5. The Nomination Forms shall be signed by the candidate and by five other contributors.
6. A candidate may withdraw his/her nomination at any time before nominations close by giving written notice of his withdrawal to the Returning Officer
7. The Returning Officer shall publicise the names of the candidates as soon as practicable after the closing of nominations.
8. The elections shall be held between 2:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2003 and contributors shall cast their votes at the following places: -

9. The Returning Officer shall appoint a person to preside at each Polling Place.
10. Each Ballot Paper for the election shall be similar to Annexure "A" and a Ballot Paper shall be in valid if it does not comply with the relevant provisions of the Electoral Act 1965-1992.
11. The result of the election shall be determined on the basis of the preferential counting system.
12. Any dispute concerning the election shall be determined as if the provisions of Part VI of the Electoral Act 1965-1992 apply, except that the District Court shall be the Court for the dispute Elections.
