POSITION : Counsellor (Safe House)

SALARY/SCALE : \$5,167 pa (3.2)

PRIMARY PURPOSE OF POSITION:

The Counsellor for the Women's Safe House is responsible for the managing of the day to day care of residents housed at Safe House, encouraging a bond of respect and trust with residents, and help residents make decisions and choices regarding possible way forward. The Counsellor is accountable and responsible to the Director of Women's Affairs. Duty Hours will be full time 70 hours per fortnight.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Interact with residents in the general milieu of Women Safe House;
- Interact with residents in the general milieu of Women Safe House common areas;
- Assist in the coordination of services to residents; contact residents' outside service providers as necessary;
- Assist in outreach and engagement of service-resistant residents through creative, resourceful strategies that build trust and confidence;
- Assist in the initiation, facilitation and promotion of on site activities, therapeutic support groups, outings and community meetings;
- Operate all functions in lobby office, including checking visitors in and out, answering telephones and monitoring security systems;
- Maintain safety and security by monitoring all general access areas and enforcing building rules;
- Respond to emergencies and initiate action as required, including contact with emergency response system;
- Maintain daily record of significant events involving residents and building operations activities in a computer log;

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- Assist with facilities inspections;
- Respond to resident's complaints;
- Initiate appropriate response to maintenance requests;
- Participate in staff meetings and trainings;
- Assist with other property management as assigned;
- Drive government or assigned vehicle to transport women from Safe House to the hospital/police station;
- Perform any other duties as may be assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

- Minimum of year 12 education;
- Must be mature, preferably 21 years or more;
- Possess at least one year of work experience in human services;
- Possess a valid driver's license;
- Computer literate;
- Excellent communication skills both oral (English and Nauruan) and written;
- Sober habits and be of congenial, compassionate and neutral character;
- Punctual, proactive, energetic and efficient;
- Women are encouraged to apply.
