Notice is hereby given to persons whose names are registered on the Roll of voters that the Electoral Commission will carry out a Poll seeking voters' opinions on the following issue:

*'Should the membership of Parliament including the Office of the President and Ministers be reserved for Nauruans and their descendants, who became Nauruan citizens in 1968, when the Constitution came into force?'*

The counting of the votes will take place at the Parliamentary Chamber, on Saturday, 13<sup>th</sup> November 2021, at 7pm. The Electoral Commission shall, immediately after the counting of the votes, certify the results of the Poll and publish the certified results of the Poll in the Gazette.

The manner in which the Poll shall be conducted shall include voting in person or by Proxy Voting.

Take notice that voting in the Poll is mandatory.
