AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the Law Relating to Goldfields.

[Reserved 14th July, 1931; Assented to 21st October, 1931.] (a)

B^E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mining Ordin-shorttitle and ance, 1931, and shall be read with The Mining Act of 1898 (Queensland Adopted) and other Ordinances relating to mining.
- **2.** Whenever either before or after the commence-Existing ment of this Ordinance a goldfield has been or is proclaimed which includes an area hitherto included in a goldfield not less than ten years old such former goldfield shall be deemed an old goldfield.

Commencement.

- 3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.
 - Passed in Council this fourteenth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.
 - Assented to by His Excellency the Governor-General, with the advice of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia, on the twenty-first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.
