AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "Mineral Oil and Coal Ordinance, 1923."

[Reserved 13th December, 1923; Assented to 20th December, 1923.] (a)

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Mineral Short title and Oil and Coal Ordinance (No. 2), 1923.
- (2) The Mineral Oil and Coal Ordinance, 1923, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Mineral Oil and Coal Ordinances*, 1923.

Repeal of s. 2 of Principal Ordinance.

- 2. Section Two of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
- Passed in Council this thirteenth day of December, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three.
