**AN ORDINANCE**

To Amend the "*Port Moresby Electric Light and Power Ordinance, 1925.*"

**B**E it ordained by the Legislative Council of the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1924*, as follows:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Port Moresby Electric Light and Power Ordinance, 1932.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Port Moresby Electric Light and Power Ordinance, 1925*, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Port Moresby Electric Light and Power Ordinance, 1925-1932.*

**2.** After Section Eight of the Principal Ordinance the following new section is inserted:—

Supply rates,  
additional  
mode of fixing.

“8A. In addition to the powers elsewhere contained in the Ordinance the Lieutenant-Governor may by Order in Council published in the *Gazette* fix alter or revoke rates payable for the supply of electricity and the rates fixed altered or revoked as aforesaid shall take effect from the time specified in the said Order: Provided however that no increase in the existing rates shall take effect until at least forty-eight hours after such publication.”

Passed in Council this thirteenth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.
