## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Prisons Ordinance, 1919.

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Prisons* Short Title and Ordinance, 1930.
- (2) The Prisons Ordinance, 1919, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Prisons Ordinance*, 1919-1930.

Employment of Prisoners as carriers.

- 2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding at the end of Section thirty-three thereof the following new Proviso:—
  - "Provided that nothing contained in this Section shall extend to the employment of native prisoners as carriers outside the limits of a prison and prisoners undergoing sentences of hard labour may be so employed without special authority."

Commencement.

- 3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the twenty-ninth day of July One thousand nine hundred and nineteen.
  - Passed in Council this eleventh day of December, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty.
