AN ORDINANCE

Relating to Past Officers of the Public Service.

[Reserved 5th September, 1917; Assented to 10th January, 1918.] (a)

E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Past short title and incorporation. Officers' Superannuation Ordinance, 1917.
- (2) This Ordinance shall be incorporated and read as one with the Superannuation Ordinance, 1917.
- 2. Any officer who has retired from the Public Ser-certain past vice of the Territory within two years immediately pre-entitled to ceding the passing of this Ordinance shall be entitled to super-annuation allowance. receive the superannuation allowance applicable to his particular case which he would have been entitled to

receive in respect of the whole period of his past services if he had continued in the Service until after the commencement of the Superannuation Ordinance, 1917, and had complied with all the necessary provisions thereof notwithstanding that he has not paid to the Superannuation Fund Account the amount specified in Section thirteen of the last mentioned Ordinance in respect of the period of his past services.

Provided that—

- (1) the period that has elapsed since any such officer's retirement from the Service shall not be counted in computing his superannuation allowance; and
- (2) there shall be deducted from his superannuation allowance a sum equivalent to Five pounds per centum on the total salary received by him during the period of his service in respect of which the superannuation allowance is paid together with interest thereon or on the part for the time being undeducted after the rate of Five pounds per centum per annum from the date of his retirement from the Service until such equivalent sum is so deducted. Such deduction shall be made in equal sums from the first payments made on account of such superannuation allowance and may be spread over a period of Five years or such less period as the Lieutenant-Governor may order,

Passed in Council this fifth day of September, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventeen.

Assented to by His Excellency the Governor-General, with the advice of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia, on the Tenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen.
