## ORDINANCE

Relating to the Public Service.

[Reserved 5th September, 1917; Assented to 10th January, 1918.] (a)

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:-

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Superannua- short title. tion Ordinance, 1917 (No. 2).
- (2) This Ordinance shall be incorporated and read as one with the Superannuation Ordinance, 1917.
- 2. The Lieutenant-Governor by Order-in-Council may Certain from time to time direct that for the period mentioned in the Order all sums by way of contributions or such product of money portions thereof as may be expressed in the Order payable appropriated for that or becoming payable to the Superannuation Fund Account by officers whose salaries do not for the time being exceed Two hundred and fifty pounds a year shall be paid to the credit of such Account out of the moneys appropriated for that purpose prior to the date of such Order-in-Council.

- 3. For the period mentioned in the Order and to the extent therein expressed the annual salaries of such officers shall be relieved from the monthly deductions therefrom of contributions to the Superannuation Fund Account; and all payments so made under the Order-in-Council shall for the purpose of estimating superannuation allowances or gratuities but not for the purpose of refund of contributions be deemed to have been made by the officers in respect of whom or of whose salaries they were made.
- 4. No such Order shall be made in respect of contributions for services performed before the commencement of this Ordinance.
- 5. Upon the expiration of the period mentioned in the Order-in-Council the liability of any such officer to contribute to the Superannuation Fund Account shall revive as from the date of such revocation.
- 6. Nothing in this Ordinance shall authorise the expenditure of any greater sum by way of payment of contributions to the Superannuation Fund Account out of the Public Revenue than is for the time being appropriated for that purpose.

Passed in Council on this fifth day of September, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and seventeen.
