

# STATUTORY RULES.

## No. 13 of 1924.

Made under *The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908.*

The *Native Regulations, 1922* (Statutory Rules No. 3 of 1922) are amended as follows:—

1. By omitting from Paragraph (i) of Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 87 the words "Crown servants" and the words "and others in the employ of the Government" and by inserting after the word "Constabulary" the word "and".
2. By inserting after Paragraph (i) of Sub-regulation (2) of Regulation 87 the following paragraph:—

"(ia) Crown servants and others in the employ of the Government who hold written permission to wear clothes from the Head of the Department or office in which they are employed; the permission shall last for so long as is expressed therein and may be withdrawn by the Head of the Department or office at any time except for natives especially exempted by a Resident Magistrate."
