STATUTORY RULES.

No. 4 of 1939.

Made under the Public Hospitals Ordinance, 1911.

The $Public\ Hospital\ Rules$, 1923 (Statutory Rules No. 13 of 1923) are amended as follows:—

1. By adding at the end thereof the following further Rule and Schedule:-

Radiographic Examination.

29. Patients may be admitted purely for the purposes of radiographic examination and the charges and conditions relating to such examination shall be as set out in Schedule 1 of these rules.

SCHEDULE, 1.

RADIOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION CHARGES.

- (a) Radiographic examinations of alimentary tract by opaque meals—Two guineas;
- (b) Cholecystographic examinations—Two guineas;
- (c) Pyleographic examinations—Two guineas.
- (d) Ordinary radiographic examinations—One guinea;
- (e) Dental radiographic examinations—Ten shillings and sixpence;
- (f) Radiographic screenings—Ten shillings and sixpence.

Medical officer to receive half fees. Film to be property of the patient. No fees to be charged to natives.
