

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 7 of 1940.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907* (No. 2 of 1907).

The *Public Service Regulations, 1939* (Statutory Rules No. 12 of 1939), are amended as follows:—

1. By adding at the end of Regulation 42 thereof the following further proviso:—

“ Provided further that when an officer applies for vacation leave as from its due date and is informed that owing to the exigencies of the Service such leave cannot be granted until some later date such officer may, notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (d) of this section, be granted without special application an additional period of vacation leave of four days for each completed month he is detained beyond the due date.”
