STATUTORY RULES.

No. 5 of 1919.

MADE UNDER THE "QUARANTINE ORDINANCE, 1913" (No. VI. of 1913).

1. The Commonwealth Provisional Regulations under the *Quarantine Act*, 1908, made the 17th day of August, 1911, as adopted by the *Quarantine Ordinance*, 1913, are amended as follows:—

Regulation 14 is amended by inserting after the words "plague or cholera" the words "10 days if such disease is Spanish Influenza."

After the heading "PART IVB.—MISCELLANEOUS" and before Regulation 65 the following new Regulation is inserted—

"62. All quarantine officers and authorized persons going and on board, and during the time they remain on board any vessel subject to quarantine, when any Proclamation declaring any place outside Papua to be infected with Spanish Influenza is in force, shall, whether or not such oversea vessel's port of departure was such place, wear a mask of a pattern approved by the Chief Quarantine Officer."
