PROCLAMATION MADE PURSUANT TO SECTION 9 OF THE ANIMALS PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION ORDINANCE, 1911 PROHIBITING THE REMOVAL OF ANIMALS WITHIN THE TERRITORY OF PAPUA.

PROCLAMATION. (1)

Animals Prohibition and Restriction Ordinance, 1911, of the Territory of Papua.

PROHIBITION OF REMOVAL OF ANIMALS.

WHEREAS by section 9 of the Animals Prohibition and Restriction Ordinance, 1911, of the Territory of Papua, it is amongst other things provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may from time to time with the advice of the Executive Council by Proclamation in the Gazette prohibit or put restrictions on the removal of any animals from one portion of the Territory to any other portion of the Territory:

And Whereas by the provisions of the Ordinances Interpretation Ordinance 1949 any reference in an Ordinance of the Territory of Papua to the Lieutenant-Governor shall be read as a reference to the Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea:

Now therefore, I, Jack Keith Murray, the Administrator of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Animals Prohibition and Restriction Ordinance, 1911, of

the Territory of Papua and all other powers me enabling, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby proclaim and declare that on and after the first day of March, 1951, the removal of any animal from a place in the Territory of Papua to another place in the Territory of Papua is absolutely prohibited unless the conditions relating to the removal of animals laid down by the Regulations under the Animals Prohibition and Restriction Ordinance, 1911, are first complied with.

Given under my Hand at Port Moresby, this twelfth day of January, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one, and in the fifteenth year of His Majesty's reign.
