

# POST AND TELEGRAPH—

## POST AND TELEGRAPH (PAPUA) ORDINANCE 1951.<sup>(1)</sup>

### No. 12 of 1951.

#### An Ordinance to amend the Post and Telegraph Ordinance 1912-1947 of the Territory of Papua.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua and New Guinea Act 1949-1950*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph (Papua) Ordinance 1951*.<sup>(1)</sup> Short title  
and citation.

(2.) The *Post and Telegraph Ordinance, 1912-1947*<sup>(2)</sup> of the Territory of Papua is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Post and Telegraph Ordinance 1912-1951*.

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the *Gazette*.<sup>(1)</sup> Commencement.

3. Section seventeen of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

4. Section seventeen A of the Principal Ordinance is repealed.

5. Section ninety-five of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after paragraph (l) thereof the following paragraph:—

“(la) prescribing the rates to be charged for the conveyance of postal articles posted within the Territory of Papua for delivery therein or for transmission abroad;”.

Third Schedule.

6. The Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is repealed.
