

AMENDMENT OF PRIVATE MAIL-BAGS REGULATIONS, 1947.⁽¹⁾

Regulations.

No. 36 of 1951.

1. Regulation 10 of the *Private Mail-Bags Regulations, 1947*,⁽²⁾ is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (1) thereof, and inserting in its stead the following new sub-paragraph:—

“(1) The fees payable in respect of any service shall be as shown in the following table:—

Make-up Frequency.	Fee.
Where conveyed by <i>Mailman</i> :—	
(1) Not more than thrice weekly	£1 10s. per annum .
(2) More than thrice but not more than six times weekly	£3 per annum.
(3) More than six times weekly	10s. per annum for each despatch weekly.
Where conveyed by <i>Private Messenger</i> :—	
(1) Not more than once daily	£1 10s. per annum.
(2) More than once daily	£3 per annum.”
