**REMOVAL OF ANIMALS.**

**I**T is hereby notified that general permission is given for the unrestricted removal within the Territory of New Guinea of the following classes of animals:—

- (a) Bees;
- (b) Birds, including domestic poultry;
- (c) Cats; and
- (d) Dogs.

Such general permission will apply also to the removal of Pigs excluding only the removal of Pigs out of the Central Highlands District.

It must be understood that this permission does not apply to movement of such animals into or out of the Territory of New Guinea.
