

SUPPLY ORDINANCE (No. 1) OF 1951-52.<sup>(1)</sup>

## No. 15 of 1951.

**An Ordinance to grant and apply out of the Public Revenue a sum for the Service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.**

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua and New Guinea Act 1949*, as follows:—

- Short title.** 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Supply Ordinance (No. 1) of 1951-52.*<sup>(1)</sup>
- Grant of £1,344,440.** 2. Subject to authorization from the Administrator, the Treasurer may issue out of the Public Revenue and apply for the service of the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, the sum of One million, three hundred and forty-four thousand four hundred and forty pounds.
- Appropriation.** 3. The sum granted by this Ordinance is appropriated for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule to this Ordinance in relation to the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two.
- Date of Commencement.** 4. This Ordinance shall take effect from the first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.

## THE SCHEDULE.

## ADVANCE TO THE TREASURER.

To enable the Treasurer to make advances to public officers and to meet annual expenditure for the financial year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-two, particulars of which afterwards will be included in an Appropriation Ordinance.
