

ALIENS REGISTRATION ORDINANCE 1925.⁽¹⁾

No. 18 of 1925.

An Ordinance to amend the Aliens Registration Act 1920 of the Parliament of the Commonwealth in its application to the Territory.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Aliens Registration Ordinance 1925*.⁽¹⁾ Short title.

2. In this Ordinance, “the Act” means the *Aliens Registration Act 1920* of the Parliament of the Commonwealth. Definition.

3. In the application of the Act to the Territory— Application of Aliens Registration Act 1920.
 - (a) section three shall be read as if, at the end of the definition of “Alien” there were added the words “but does not include a native of the Territory”; and
 - (b) section five shall be deemed to be omitted, and the following section inserted in its stead:—

“5. For the purposes of this Act, the Administrator may appoint Aliens Registration Officers⁽²⁾ in such places⁽³⁾ in the Territory as the Administrator specifies by notice in the *New Guinea Gazette*.”

Aliens Registration Officers.

(2) Pursuant to Section 3, the Administrator, by six notices, all dated 26th July, 1935, and all published in *N.G. Gaz.* of 31st July, 1935, appointed the persons for the time being holding the office of District Officer administering respectively the Morobe, Kieta, New Ireland, Manus, Sepik and Madang Districts, to be Aliens Registration Officers in Salamaua, Kieta, Kavieng, Lorengau, Wewak and Madang respectively. The Administrator has also by notices published in *N.G. Gaz.* appointed persons by name to be Aliens Registration Officers at each of the places referred to in footnote (3) to this Ordinance.

(3) Pursuant to Section 3, the Administrator, by notice dated 25th July, 1935, and published in *N.G. Gaz.* of 31st July, 1935, specified the following places as places in which the Administrator may appoint Aliens Registration Officers:—
Rabaul, Kokopo, Gasmata, Talasea, Kavieng, Namatanai, Lorengau, Wewak, Aitape, Vanimo, Angoram, Ambunti, Madang, Salamaua, Lae, Wau, Kieta, Buka Passage.
