DISTRICT COURTS ORDINANCE
(No. 2) 1924.⁽¹⁾

No. 18 of 1924.

An Ordinance relating to the Date of Commencement
of the District Courts Ordinance 1924.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920*, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *District Courts Ordinance (No. 2) 1924*.⁽¹⁾

Annulment of notice of commencement of *District Courts Ordinance 1924*.

2.—(1.) The notice⁽²⁾ published prior to the commencement of this Ordinance in pursuance of section two of the *District Courts Ordinance 1924*⁽³⁾ whereby the date for the commencement of that Ordinance is fixed, is hereby annulled, and that Ordinance shall not be deemed to have commenced on the date fixed in that notice.

(2.) The issue of the notice annulled by this section shall not affect the power to fix, in pursuance of section two of the *District Courts Ordinance 1924*,⁽³⁾ the date upon which that Ordinance shall commence.

(2) This notice, dated 11th March, 1924, and published in *N.G. Gaz.* of 15th March, 1924, fixed 30th April, 1924, as the date on which the *District Courts Ordinance 1924* should commence.
