An Ordinance to amend the Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1921-1937.

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of New Guinea, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the New Guinea Act 1920-1935, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1939.⁽¹⁾
- (2.) The Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1921-1937 is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the Laws Repeal and Adopting Ordinance 1921-1939.

Amendment of Third Schedule to Principal

- 3.—(1.) The Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting the words and figures "Weights and Measures Ordinance 1913."
- (2.) This section shall not commence until a date to be fixed by the Administrator by notice in the New Guinea Gazette. (1)
