

WORKERS' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1941.⁽¹⁾

No. 15 of 1941.

An Ordinance to amend the Workers' Compensation Ordinance 1941.

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of New Guinea, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920-1935*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Workers' Compensation Ordinance (No. 2) 1941*.⁽¹⁾

Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Workers' Compensation Ordinance 1941* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Workers' Compensation Ordinances 1941*.

2. The notice fixing the date of the commencement of the Principal Ordinance, dated the eleventh day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-one and published in the *New Guinea Gazette* on the fourteenth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and forty-one, shall be deemed to be, and at all times to have been, inoperative and of no effect, and the power conferred upon the Administrator by section two of the Principal Ordinance shall be exercisable as if such notice fixing the date of the commencement of the Principal Ordinance had not been given.

Notice of commencement of Principal Ordinance to be inoperative.

3. Sections four, five, and six of this Ordinance shall commence on the date of the commencement of the Principal Ordinance.

Commencement of sections 4, 5 and 6.
