

# ALIENS ORDINANCE, 1922.<sup>(1)</sup>

## No. 15 of 1922.

### An Ordinance to amend the Law relating to Aliens.

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Aliens Ordinance, 1922.*<sup>(1)</sup> Short title.

2. This Ordinance shall commence and take effect on the day on which the *Nationality Act, 1920*, of the Parliament of the Commonwealth shall by any Act of the Parliament of the Commonwealth be extended with or without amendment to the Territory.<sup>(2)</sup> Commencement.

3. The *Aliens Ordinance, 1911-1919*, except Sections one and three thereof are repealed but such repeal shall not affect the rights or status of any person naturalized under that Ordinance. Repeal, exceptions and saving.

(2) The *Nationality Act 1922* inserted in the *Nationality Act 1920* a new section (Section 5A) which provided that the Act should extend to, *inter alia*, the Territory of Papua. The *Nationality Act 1922* commenced on 18.10.1922, the date of assent.
