

CURRENCY ORDINANCE, 1911.⁽¹⁾

No. 13 of 1911.

An Ordinance relating to Currency and Legal Tender.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the "*Currency Ordinance, 1911.*"⁽¹⁾ Short title.

It shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor by Proclamation published in the *Gazette*.⁽¹⁾

2. The Act 19 Vic. No. 3 (Queensland adopted) being an Act to Regulate the Currency is repealed. Repeal.

3. A tender of payment of money if made in-coins which are legal tender in Australia under any law for the time being of the Commonwealth of Australia shall be a legal tender in the Territory. Coins which are legal tender in the Commonwealth to be legal tender in the Territory.
