

DENTISTS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS, 1941. ⁽¹⁾

Statutory Rules.

No. 11 of 1941.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Dentists Registration Regulations, 1941.* ⁽¹⁾

2. An application for registration shall be in the form prescribed in the Schedule to these regulations.

3. An application for registration shall be accompanied by the following certificates:—

- (a) A certificate establishing that the applicant is qualified for registration given under the hand of the proper authority in the State or Territory of or under the control of the Commonwealth from which the applicant comes;
- (b) A certificate from a Justice of the Peace knowing the applicant certifying that he is of good character:

Provided that in the event of such a certificate being unobtainable the certificate may be furnished by a Judge, Magistrate or Police Officer not below the rank of Sergeant:

Provided that no certificate as prescribed by this subparagraph need be furnished by a dentist practising in the Territory at the commencement of the Ordinance.

4. The register shall contain the particulars required to be furnished upon the application. Each entry shall be authenticated under the hand of the Registrar-General.
