

EXPLOSIVES STORAGE RATES ORDINANCE, 1914.⁽¹⁾

No. 9 of 1914.

An Ordinance relating to Explosives.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Explosives Storage Rates Ordinance, 1914.*⁽¹⁾ Short title.

2. *The Inflammable Oils Ordinance of 1906* is repealed. Repeal.

3.—(1.) The charges and rent for the storage of gun powder or other explosive substances now or hereafter to be deposited in a Government magazine under the provisions of *The Navigation Act of 1876* (Queensland adopted) to be paid by the importer or owner thereof shall be at such rate as the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council⁽²⁾ shall from time to time determine. Charges and rent for storage of explosives.

(2.) The rate so determined shall be declared by notice⁽³⁾ in the *Gazette*.
