

NATIVE OFFENDERS EXCLUSION ORDINANCE, 1930. ⁽¹⁾

No. 4 of 1930.

An Ordinance to Exclude Certain Native Offenders from Towns.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Native Offenders Exclusion Ordinance, 1930.*⁽¹⁾

Exclusion from towns.

2. No native convicted of any offence of an indecent nature against a white woman or girl shall upon discharge from custody come or remain within the boundaries of any town.

Penalty.

3. Any native convicted of a breach of the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanour and is liable to imprisonment with hard labour for one year.
