

QUARANTINE ORDINANCE, 1938. ⁽¹⁾⁽²⁾

No. 14 of 1938.

An Ordinance relating to Quarantine.

BE it ordained by the Legislative Council for the Territory of Papua, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Papua Act, 1905-1934*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Quarantine Ordinance, 1938*,⁽¹⁾ and shall be incorporated and read as one with the *Quarantine Ordinance, 1913-1937*. Short title.
2. The place described in the Schedule hereto shall be a place appointed a Quarantine Station for the purpose of the quarantine of persons. Appointment of quarantine station.
3. No legal proceedings civil or criminal shall be instituted in any Court of law by any person for or on account of or in respect of having undergone quarantine prior to the passing of this Ordinance in the place hereby appointed a Quarantine Station by reason of such place not then having been so appointed. Restriction on taking legal proceedings.
4. The Lieutenant-Governor⁽²⁾ may by Proclamation⁽³⁾ at any time suspend all or any of the provisions of this Ordinance. Suspension of Ordinance.
5. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the twenty-eighth day of September, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight. Commencement.

SCHEDULE.

DESCRIPTION.

All that piece or parcel of land situate on the North side of Port Moresby-Rouna Road in the said Territory containing twenty-five acres be the same a little more or less; being Portion 42, District 8. Commencing at a point situated on the North side of the Port Moresby-Rouna Road being the most

HEALTH—

Southern corner of Portion 28; thence by the Northern side of the aforesaid Port Moresby-Rouna Road bearing $223^{\circ} 44'$ for a distance of one thousand two hundred and ninety-eight and seven-tenths links; thence by a line bearing $320^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of two thousand and seven and four-tenths links; thence by a line bearing $50^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of one thousand two hundred and ninety-one links; thence by the South-West boundary of Portion 28 bearing $140^{\circ} 00'$ for a distance of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five and six-tenths links to the point of commencement. All bearings true.
