APPOINTMENT OF HOLIDAY

I, THOMAS KINGSTON CRITCHLEY, High Commissioner, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 133(5) and (6) of the *Public Service (Interim Arrangements) Act 1973*, as amended to date, and all other powers me enabling and being of the opinion that it is desirable that in the year 1975, the Anniversary of the Birthday of the Sovereign should not be a holiday, hereby—

(a) declare that that day shall not be a holiday in the year 1975; and

(b) appoint 16th June, 1975, to be a holiday in the place of the Anniversary of the Birthday of the Sovereign in the year 1975.
